#### **GOD IS NOT A MAN**

Some popular movies of the past have pictured the God of the Bible as a little old white-haired man possessing the same form, frailties and weaknesses as humans. Yet the Bible declares in Numbers 23:19, "**God is not a man**, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?" God is not a man, nor does He possess the weaknesses common to man. God is greater than man (Job 33:12). God is not a physical being but is a spiritual being (John 4:24). He is not subject to the frailties of the physical man. He does not grow old nor does He suffer disease nor is He subject to death for He is eternal (Genesis 21:23; Deut. 33:27). Unlike man, God does not possess the ability to tell a lie nor renege on His promises (Titus 1:2; 2 Corinthians 1:20; 2 Peter 3:9). God's ways and thoughts are higher than those of man (Isaiah 55:9).
