WHITE WASHED TOMBS & DEAD MENS

BONES—By Jonnie Hutchison

All of us have heard the term "hypocrite." A hypocrite is someone who pretends to be something other than he or she really is. A hypocrite says one thing and does another. Jesus described the hypocrites of His day in these words, "For you are

like whitewashed tombs which indeed appear beautiful outwardly, but inside are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness. Even so you also outwardly appear

righteous to men, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness" (Matthew 23:27-28).

The Dead Bones of Speech. Have you ever heard someone praise God and then turn right around and use God's name in vain or use some euphemism or other curse word? Is this not hypocrisy? One who would follow God must guard and control what he says. Jesus emphasized the seriousness of what we say in the words, "For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned." (Matthew 12:37). The Bible shows the evil of hypocrisy in ones speech—"Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so" (James 3:10). Let your speech be "always with grace, seasoned with salt" lest you be full of the dead bones of hypocrisy (Col. 4:16).

The Dead Bones of Thought. Until one expresses his thoughts no other human being knows what ones thoughts are. We are not mind read-

ers. That means that one may be thinking evil thoughts and be able to hide them from others, at least for a time. Eventually evil thoughts will result in evil actions. Jesus said, "...an evil man

out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil...." (Mark 6:45). The Bible teaches that one commits adultery with a woman in his heart (mind or by what he thinks) if he looks upon her to lust after her (Matthew 5:28). One may hide thoughts of malice, hatred envy and vengeance as well. Ones peers may never know of such thoughts but without genuine repentance one who has them is full of the dead bones of hypocrisy.

Those who play the hypocrite will not go to heaven. The Word of God tells us, "Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking" (1 Peter 2:1). Let each of us examine ourselves to make sure we are not "whitewashed tombs full of dead men's bones."




