FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES

God designed and originated the family unit. God told the first man and the helpmeet He created for him, “*Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh*” (Genesis 3:24). Later Jesus taught, “*What God has joined together let not man separate*” (Matthew 19:6). The family, as God designed it, is absolutely essential to provide stability to society. The breakdown of family is one of the reasons why there is so much upheaval in our world today.


SPOUSAL RESPONSIBILITIES. In order to have a strong family there must be strong marriages. Husband and wife have their individual and joint God-given responsibilities that must be kept if a marriage is to continue to be stable. Husbands must love their wives and act as the head of their homes while wives must love their husbands and be submissive to them. “*Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. Therefore, just as the wives be to their own husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her*” (Ephesians 5:22-25). Mutual

love and respect between husband and wife and submission to the will of God by both will create a stable environment for those blessed in their marriage with children.

PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES. Becoming a parent is both a blessing and a grave responsibility. Parents must provide for both the physical and spiritual needs of their children. Sadly, far too many parents provide the former and ignore the latter. Parents are required by God to “*Train up a child in the way he should go. And when he is old he will not depart from it*” (Prov. 22:6). The New Testament instructs fathers, “*not to provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord*” (Ephesians 6:4). Children must be taught to obey their parents which requires the proper exercise of parental discipline. Parents must rule the home, rather than the children doing so. Parents must exercise their authority over their children and help the children learn that no means no. Giving in to every whim of a child may result in a lifetime of hurt. Children need boundaries. Disobedient children must learn that there are unpleasant consequences for disobedience. The spiritual welfare of ones family is of much more

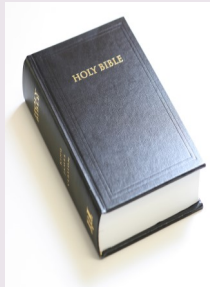

importance than their physical needs. However, neither should be neglected.

RESPONSIBILITY OF CHILDREN.

Children must both obey and respect their parents. *"Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother which is the first commandment with promise, that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth"* (Ephesians 6:1-3). Consistent parenting creates respect in the minds of children for their parents. Most children want to please their parents. 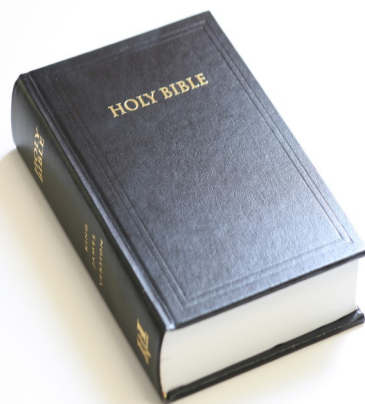
WHY SHOULD WE HAVE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD'S WORD?

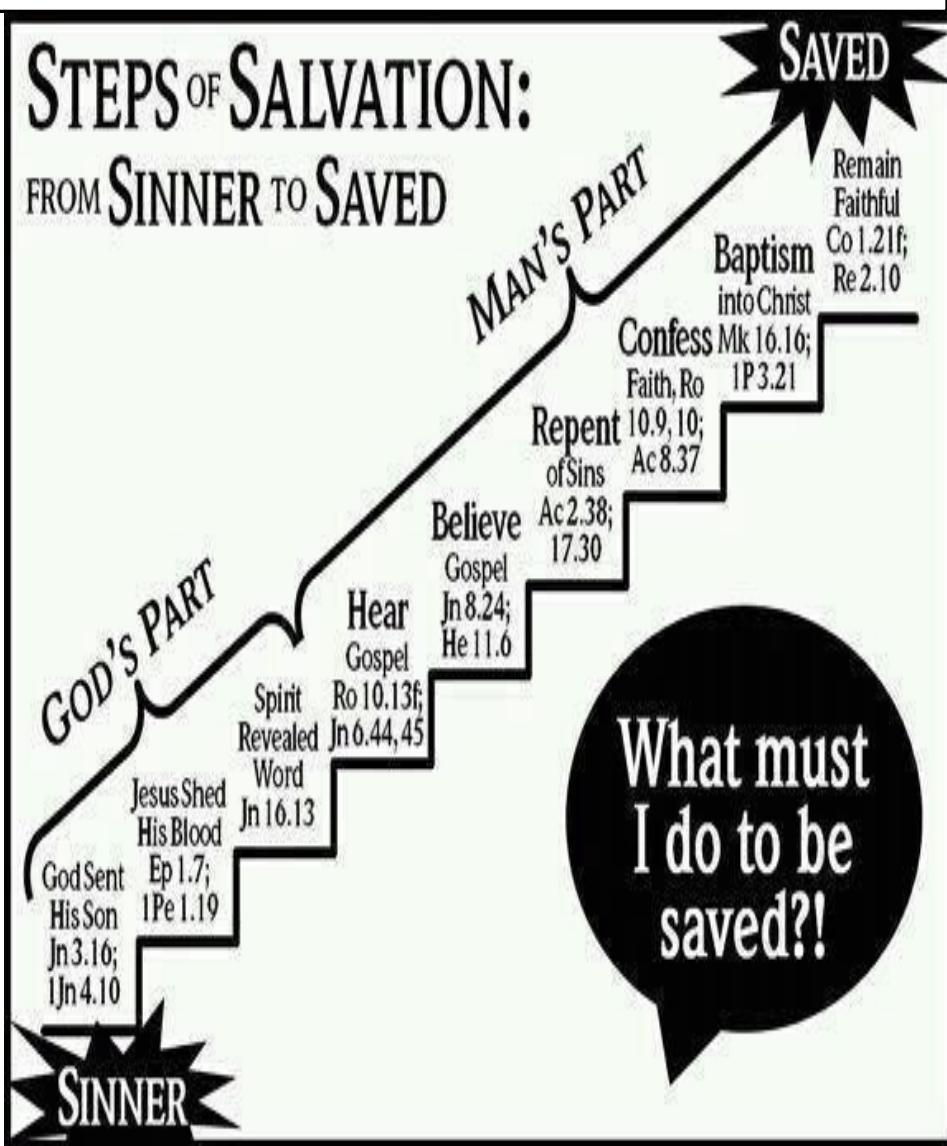
