(James 2:26). The outward man dies, the inward man lives on. The Bible tells us, "... Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day" (2 Corinthians 4:16-17). Death is not the end of our existence. Each of us will exist in eternity for we were made in the spiritual image of God. Where we each exist in eternity is determined by what we do now as we live in our physical bodies. "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad" (2 Corinthians

5:10).

The very fact that physical life is so brief and eternity is never ending should motivate any thinking person of the immediate need of making sure that when ones life here ends, he or she has already prepared for what comes after. Let us each give heed to what Solomon wrote by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit about the very purpose of life: "Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all. For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil" (Ecclesiastes 12:13-14).


The church building is located southeast of Murray one mile off highway 641 - Near the corner of the Green Plain and Murray Paris Roads. We look forward to seeing you!
