THE SPIRITUAL BIRTH

In John 3 Nicodemus comes to Jesus acknowledging Him as a teacher from God in recognition of the miracles Jesus had done. The answer Jesus gave Nicodemus obviously surprised him. Jesus said, *“Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man **be born again**, he cannot see the kingdom of God”* (Vrs. 3). At first Nicodemus concluded that Jesus was talking about physical birth for he asked Jesus, *“How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?”* (Vrs. 4). Jesus explained that he was not speaking of physical birth but a spiritual birth when He said, *“Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born **of water and of the Spirit**, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God”* (Vrs. 5). The elements of the spiritual birth are two – water and the Spirit. Some mistakenly believe that the water of which Jesus spoke refers to physical birth and the Spirit to spiritual birth. However, that argument fails when one considers that Jesus used the coordinating conjunction “and” to tie both water and the Spirit to the spiritual birth making both conditions to enter-

ing the Kingdom of God. In addition, Jesus was contrasting being born of the water and the Spirit with the misunderstanding expressed by Nicodemus of entering the second time into his mother's womb to be born.

What is the water in the spiritual birth? To answer that question allow me to ask another – what is the only command in the New Testament associated with the conversion of sinners that requires water? In every single case of conversion recorded in the book of Acts, water baptism was commanded of penitent believers as a condition to receiving the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38, 41; 8:12-13, 36, 38; 9:18; 10:48; 16:15, 33; 19:5; 22:16). No wonder the Bible declares, *“The like figure whereunto baptism doth also now save us”* (1 Peter 3:21). Understand that it is not the water that washes away one's sins. (see Revelation 1:5; 1 Peter 1:18-19). But one spiritually reaches the cleansing blood of Jesus in being immersed in water into the death of Christ (John 19:32-33; Acts 22:16; Romans 6:3-4; Galatians 3:26-27).

What does it mean to be born of the Spirit? In 1 Peter 1:22-23 Peter wrote to those who had purified their souls in "obeying the truth through the Spirit." He went on to describe this obedience to the truth as "having been **born again**, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, **through the word of God** which lives and abides forever." When as a penitent confessing believer, one obeys what God requires for salva-

tion and thus spiritually contacts the blood of Jesus, that one has been born of the water and of the Spirit.

We urge each reader to study the scripture references given in this article. If you find that you have not yet been "born again" we encourage you to act upon what you have learned is true before it is everlasting too late. The salvation of your soul is more important than anything else in your life.

GROUNDED IN TRUTH

First, God "gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors

and teachers. . .that we should no longer be tossed to and fro..." (Ephesians 4:11-15). In other words God set up a teaching program for the church so each member could be grounded in truth.

Second, God commands each member to study for ourselves. We must study to show ourselves approved unto God (2 Timothy 2:15).

Spiritual roots grow deep when personal desire drives us to study and when we spend time with godly teachers of His word (Psalm 1:1-6). We hope to see you in Bible class each week.
