

WHY HAVE A GOSPEL MEETING By Jonnie Hutchison

For many years churches of Christ have conducted "Gospel Meetings" across the country and throughout the world. Many precious souls will exist in the eternal bliss of heaven as the result of such efforts. Indeed, that is the primary reason "Gospel Meetings" were and continue to be conducted.

In our present world some suggest that gospel meetings are no longer effective. We readily admit that the Gospel Meeting is not what it used to be as far as participation is concerned. Satan knows how to utilize otherwise legitimate things such as television, entertainment, sports, the internet, etc. to distract folks from what is much more important and necessary to their salvation (1 Peter 5:8; Ephesians 6:11). Why have a Gospel Meeting?

Because it is God's plan. God's plan for man's salvation from sin still includes the preaching of the gospel. Paul, inspired by the Holy Spirit, wrote in 1 Corinthians 1:21, "For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who be*lieve.*" Without the preaching of the gospel the world does not and cannot know the God of heaven as He is revealed in the Bible. God has always sent faithful preachers into the world to make His will known to humankind. The prophets of the Old Testament were messengers or preachers of God's Word. Jesus sent the apostles into all the world to preach the gospel (Mark 16:15-16). God's plan to save man from sin has not changed nor has the means He has chosen to impart it to man through preaching. Why have a Gospel Meeting?

To Save the Lost. This is the challenge of every gospel meeting conducted by

the church. The gospel of Christ has the power to save the lost. Writing to the church in Rome Paul declared, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ for it is the **power of God to salvation**, to the Jew first and also to the Greek" (Romans 1:16). This powerful gospel must first be heard to produce salvation from sin. Jesus said, "It is written in the prophets, And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me." (John 6:45). Faith comes by hearing the Word of God (Romans 10:17). A gospel meeting gives people the opportunity to hear, believe and obey the gospel. Why have a Gospel Meeting?

To get involved. Our love for the lost and our desire to see them saved will encourage us to, not only conduct Gospel Meetings, but to become personally involved. Is there some precious soul for whom you have been praying who needs to hear the gospel? Then invite them to come with you to our Gospel Meeting. We must follow the example of Jesus who came to "seek and save that which was lost" (Luke 19:10). This is the attitude of heart that every child of God must possess. We are surrounded by souls who are ignorant of God's truth and are hopelessly lost in their sins. Using such events as a Gospel Meeting, we have the opportunity to change this tragic circumstance. But we never will if we refuse to become personally involved. Why have a Gospel Meeting?

To strengthen the saved. Gospel Meetings give Christians an opportunity to grow stronger in the faith. The lessons presented will remind us of the basic truths of the gospel, the fundamentals upon which our faith was established, which will result in a

renewal of our commitment to our Lord. Christians are told to "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Peter 3:18). Spiritual maturity doesn't automatically occur but requires a diligent and continuous effort on the part of the child of God. 2 Timothy 2:15 reads, "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." 
