WHAT CAN WASH AWAY YOUR SINS? By Jonnie Hutchison

Sin is the transgression of the will of God (1 John 3:4). What God commands us to do is good. When we fail to do the good that God commands we sin (James 1:17). The Bible tells us that "all unrighteousness is sin" (1 John 5:17). Sin is a universal affliction of man-kind. "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). All who are accountable to God have committed sin.

Ones sins separate him/her from God (Isaiah 59:1-2). Unless and until one receives forgiveness of sin he or she is separated from God and in danger of everlasting punishment in a devil's hell (Eze. 18:20; Rom. 6:223; Matt. 25:46; 1 Thess. 1:7-9). However, God does not want any person to suffer

eternal loss. He has devised a plan whereby He can be just and, at the same time, offer man the opportunity to receive the remission of sins and the hope of eternal life.

God's plan for man's salvation involves a sacrifice and thus the shedding of blood.—but not just any blood. Under the Law of Moses in the Old Testament, the blood of animals was offered as a sacrifice for sin. However, the blood of those animals could not wash away sin but only typified the blood that does have the power to wash away sin (See Hebrews chapters 9 and 10). To accomplish the forgiveness of sin required the blood of a perfect sacrifice. No animal could fill

that role and neither could any sinful man or woman. Therefore God sent His only begotten Son, conceived miraculously in the womb of a virgin, to become that perfect sacrifice for sin. "Therefore in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation *for the sins of the people*" (Hebrews 2:17). His shed blood upon the cross provides the means for all who reach His blood to be cleansed of their sins. "knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without *spot.* " (1 Peter 1:18-19).

To reach the blood of Jesus requires the sinner to accept the deity of Jesus Christ (John 8:24), to repent of sins (Acts 17:30) and to confess faith in Christ (Rom. 10:9-10). Yet, ones sins are not washed away until one completes his/her obedience to be baptized (immersed in water) into the death of Christ (Romans 6:3-4). Ananias instructed the sinner Saul. "...Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord" (Acts 22:16). It is in baptism that one reaches the blood of Jesus. Thus it is in baptism that the penitent believer receives the remission of sins (See Acts 2:38; Revelation 2:10b).

So what can wash away your sins? Nothing but the blood of Jesus! What can make you whole again? Nothing but the blood of Jesus! Be cleansed today!

To know the will of God one must spend time in the study of His Word, the Bible. "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God" (Romans 10:17).
