WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE HOLY AS GOD IS HOLY? By Lee Cox

"Be ye Holy for I am Holy", are words said by God and echoed throughout the scripture describing how one is to live before God. The question is however, how can I be Holy? How Holy is God? Is this something that can be attained today? When one begins to look at Holiness and how it relates to the Christian today, it becomes very easy to be overwhelmed.

Before we can observe the holiness in a way of imitation, we frst must observe it in a way of admiration!

Isaiah 6:1-5 gives us one of the best looks into the Holiness of God. The inspired writer speaks of the Throne of God and its surroundings. We are given this beautiful picture of how the Lord is sitting on His throne and even the angelic beings that He created were calling out how Holy God is. This 3-time mentioning is the superlative cry not to just say He is Holy but that He is extremely Holy.

When the word is applied to God in the Bible, the idea is

His purity cannot be tainted. The astonishing part about this, is not just simply God is extremely Holy in and of Himself but also the scriptures teach that even the things God comes into contact with or have a relation to are Holy as well.

The Tabernacle was the Holy Tabernacle, why? It was associated with God.

- 1. Psalm 2:6- Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.
- 2. Psalm 11:4- *The Lord is in his holy temple...*
- 3. God is so holy even the promises that drip from his lips are called holy Psalm 105:42- For he remembered his holy promise, and Abraham his servant.

The holiness of God can be overwhelming, however knowing that God isn't going to ask of us anything that cannot be attained, how can I be Holy like God? Understanding that there are many ways to accomplish this, I want to



being that worship is when the Christian draws near to God and praises Him, it is vital that this is done properly.

Leviticus 10:1-3, the infamous set of scripture where we see 2 individuals that "offer strange fre" before God and were destroyed because of it. We may be very familiar with the account given here in scripture, but have we taken the time to observe why they were destroyed.

Notice what God says in verse 3 and how it shows that unauthorized worship is not just missing the mark, but it is totally dismissing the Holiness of God, and God says I won't stand for it.

Today, the command from Leviticus is echoed once again for us in 1 Peter 1:15-16. Making the proclamation that God still requires His Children to be holy in their lives. The amazing part about it all is that God does not just make mention of this and never give instructions on how to accomplish it. Just as the Jews would have read though and understand the Inspired book of Leviticus you and I not only have it for our learning (Romans 15:4); but we also have the book of 1 Peter. Showing us today that no matter what position we find ourselves in, in this life, we can achieve Holy living before God.

If we can take anything from the scripture when trying to understand the Staggering Holiness of God, let it be this. God is holy and we on our own are not. God is holy and high and lifted up and we dare not rush into His presence in an unholy fashion.

BY WHAT AUTHORITY? By Jonnie Hutchison

"Now when He came into the temple," the chief priests and the elders of the people confronted Him as He was teaching, and said, "By what authority are You doing these things? And who gave You this authority?" But Jesus answered and said to them, "I also will ask you one thing, which if you tell Me, I likewise will tell you by what authority I do these things: The baptism of John—where was it from? From heaven or from men?" (Matthew 21:23-25). The Greek word translated "authority" has the meaning of permission. The Jewish leaders were asking Jesus who gave Him the permission or the right to teach and to work miracles. Jesus answered that he would tell who gave Him authority if they would answer His question

Jesus' question put these Jewish leaders in a dilemma. "If we say, 'From heaven,' He will say to us, 'Why then did you not believe him?' But if we say, 'From men,' we fear the multitude, for all count John as a prophet. So they answered Jesus and said, "We do not know." Jesus then said, "Neither will I tell you by what authority I do these things."

This interaction shows the importance Jesus placed on divine authority. Later Jesus would say, "...*All authority has been given unto Me in heaven and on earth*" (Matthew 28:19). What Jesus taught, He taught by divine authority. He had God's permission to teach and work miracles. Since Jesus, the Son of God and our Savior, expressed the importance and necessity of divine authority

Should we not seek divine permission for every belief, teaching, and practice in religious

matters? Have you considered the question of divine authority in what you believe and practice in your desire to please God?

How can we know if what we believe, and practice is permitted by God? Friends, God authorizes today through His written word in the New Testament. If one cannot find divine permission in the New Testament for what he believes and practices in religion, then he is practicing that for which he has no divine authority. Sadly, many religious people never question their religious beliefs and practices. They never investigate the scriptures to seek divine authority. Have you? Why do you believe and practice what you do? Is it because you have searched the scriptures for divine authority or simply because it is something you have always been taught and believed? Is it from God or men is still a most relevant question.
