BE LIKE A CHILD By Jonnie Hutchison

"At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who then is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?"² Then Jesus called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them, 3^{3} and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.⁴ Therefore whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. ' Whoever receives one little child like this in My name re*ceives Me.*" (Matthew 18:1-5).

In their misunderstanding of the nature of the kingdom, the Lord's disciples seemed to be most concerned about who would be the greatest in that kingdom. In the kingdoms of this world those who would be the greatest would be those who were the most aggressive, those who craved power and who sought positions of authority over others. But the very nature of the kingdom of which Christ spoke demanded an entirely different approach. Jesus uses a child to illustrate the attitude of heart that is necessary to greatness in His spiritual kingdom. It

contrary, greatness in the kingdom of our Lord is measured by genuine conversion and humility as possessed by a little child. What are some other characteristics of children that those in the kingdom would do well to imitate?

Children have an eagerness to please. Most little children want to please their parents. They want their parents to think well of them. Little children do not want their parents to be angry with them for something they have done wrong. Their love for their parents motivates them to act in such a way as to please them.

This eagerness to please must be the attitude of one who would come to God. Love for God should be a motivating factor in our desire to please Him. Jesus said, "If you love Me, keep My commandments" (John 14:15).

Children have an eagerness to learn. Children are curious and interested in learning newthings. Children ask a lot of questions as they seek to learn. Parents are given the responsibility



ward maturity. The most important aspect of parental responsibility in this matter is teaching children about God and their responsibility to their Creator. Parents are to bring their children up in the "training and admonition of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4). The greatest failure of any parent is to fail to teach their children the Word of God, for such failure has eternal consequences which no loving parent wants for his or her child.

Those who would come to God must possess this desire to learn the will of God. Jesus said, "It is written in the prophets, And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me" (John 6:45). This desire to hear and learn must continue as one grows toward spiritual maturity. "As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the Word that you may grow thereby" (1 Peter 2:2). This desire to learn from the Word of God must be a lifetime desire for those who would enter the kingdom of heaven. 2 Peter 3:18 reads, "but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."

Jesus said that little children are humble. He declared that unless one was converted and humbled himself as a little child he could not even enter the kingdom of heaven, let alone be considered as great in the kingdom.

Little children are submissive to their parents. Those who would have God as their spiritual Father will be submissive and obedient to His will (Hebrews 5:8-9). Loving parents set boundaries for their children for their physical welfare. Our loving God sets boundaries in His Word for the spiritual welfare of His children (2 John 9-11).

Who is the greatest in the Kingdom of heaven? Jesus said it is those who are converted and humble themselves as a little child. Does His description describe you?
