ARE YOU SURE YOU WANT TO TAKE THAT CHANCE? By Jonnie Hutchison

A standard dictionary defines the word "chance" as "the possibility of something happening." We hear phrases like "taking a chance" or "chances are this or that will happen." "Taking a chance" is the idea of behaving in a way that leaves one vulnerable to danger or failure. Those who gamble for money are taking a chance of losing all they bet. More often than not, the chance they take results in loss rather than gain. Those who engage in recreational drug use (alcohol, marihuana, cocaine, meth, etc.) are taking a chance of becoming addicted to their drug of choice. The he chances are very high that they will. Taking such chances always involves an uncertain outcome.

The majority of people in this world are :"taking a chance" when it comes to their most precious possession. They are gambling with their soul. They are choosing sin over salvation. They God does not exist or that He is the sinner. They are betting that and to be admired among all the Bible is untrue and what it

says about sin and the judgment, and heaven and hell is nothing more than a myth.

Dear reader, are you willing to take a chance that the words of Psalm 14:1, which reads, "The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God," are not true? Are you willing to ignore the abundant evidence of the existence of God revealed both in the Bible and in nature itself? (Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:20ff).

The following is a story of nature demonstrating the fact that struggles are a necessary part of growth and development for the Christian in this life. God places these struggles (or trials) before us to prepare us for that perfect home in heaven with Him.

The Man and The Cocoon

One day a small opening appeared on

a cocoon. A man sat and watched for the butterfly for several hours as it struggled to force its body through that little hole. Then it seemed to stop making any progress. It appeared as if it had gotten as far as it could and could go no further. The man decided to help the butterfly,

so he took a pair of scissors and snipped off the remaining bit of the cocoon. The butterfly emerged easily but had a swollen body and small, shriveled wings.

The man continued to watch the butterfly because he expected that, at any moment, the wings would enlarge and expand to support the body, which would contract in time. Neither happened! The butterfly spent the rest of its life crawling around with a swollen body and shriveled wings. It was never able to fly.

What the man in his kindness and haste did not understand was that the re-

straining cocoon and the struggle required for the butterfly to get through the tiny opening was God's way of forcing fluid from the body of the butterfly into its wings so that it would be ready for flight once it achieved its freedom from the cocoon

As Christians, struggles (or trials) are exactly what we need in our lives to grow

and develop properly. If God allowed us to go through our Christian life without any obstacles, it would cripple us spiritually. Like the butterfly, we would not be as strong as we could have been. We could never fly!



Conclusion


