God said, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him". In Hebrews 1:1-2, we read "God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds". Christ is God's spokesman today. What He says in His Word is true, good, and right. When seeking spiritual direction and guidance in life, we must look for it in the right place and from the right One. It is only by looking to the Lord and His Word that we can find the help we need in this life to prepare for the way to Heaven.

"EXHORT ONE ANOTHER" By Jonnie Hutchison

Hebrews 3:13 reads, "but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin." The Word "exhort" is used fourteen times in the English New Testament. The Greek word is parakaleo (par-ak-al-eh'-o) and, has several uses in the New Testament. Thayer says, "it combines the ideas of exhorting and comforting and encouraging." (Romans 12:8).

The Hebrew writer indicates in Hebrews 3:13 that exhortation is something Christians are to do for one another. This exhortation is necessary in avoiding the hardening power and deceitful nature of sin.

The inspired Paul often used the word exhort when addressing he church. To the church in Corinth Paul wrote, "Therefore I thought it necessary to **exhort** the brethren...." (2 Cor. 9:5). To the church in Thessalonica Paul wrote, "Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord Jesus...." (1 Thess 4:1a). Paul wrote to Timothy to "...teach and exhort these things" (1 Timothy 6:2) and to "Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching" (2 Timothy 4:2). One of the qualifications for elders found in Titus 1:9 is they must be "holding fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able, by sound doctrine, both to exhort and

convict." In reference to not forsaking the assembly the Hebrew writer says to be "exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching" (Hebrews 10:25).

Hebrews 3:13 speaks to the frequency of exhortation in the words "exhort one another daily." This testifies to the need and importance of exhortation. Christians are faced daily with making proper decisions that are pleasing to God. Exhortation from good brethren can help us to make right choices and avoid the sorrow of wrong choices. We must depend upon one another for encouragement and comfort as

we face the struggles and trials of this life.

As the recipients of exhortation provided by faithful brothers and sisters in Christ, we should rejoice knowing that their exhortation is motivated by love and deep concern for our spiritual welfare. When Paul ended his second letter to the church in Corinth he **exhorted**, "Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you." Let us receive this wonderful exhortation and apply it by exhorting one another to continued faithfulness.
