just an expression of grateful affection but of total submission. Jesus said, "If you love Me, keep My commandments" (John 14:15). Jesus Himself left us an example of this submissive love for the Father in the words of John 8:29 , "And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him." Again Jesus declared, "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me" (John 6:38).

John, often referred to as 'the apostle of love." wrote, "For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome" (1 John 5:3). The Bible affirms that it is those who "know not God and obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ" upon whom Jesus will take vengeance when He comes again (2 Thess. 1:7-10). If one loves God he/she will express that love in obedience to what He has commanded.

"Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me." (Luke 9:23). Selfdenial is one of the most obvious expressions of genuine love. It is putting the good of another before self. It is an expression of selflessness. It is often characteristic of the love shown in relationship to family and friends as one puts their needs above his

"submitting to one another in the fear of God." (Eph. 5:21). Wives are to express their love for their husbands by submission (Eph. 5:22; Cool. 3:18). Loves greatest expression is in relinquishing ones own desires in submission to those of his/her God.

A loving submission to God is expressed in one's effort to save the lost. God expressed His love for all of us in providing the means of our salvation through the blood of Jesus (John 3:16; Romans 5:8-9). We express our love for God and for those lost in sin as we fulfill our divine obligation to teach and preach the good news of salvation. It would do well for each of us to give serious consideration to the question, am I doing what I can do to express my love for

those ensnared in the bondage of sin? Am I truly letting my light shine? (Matthew 5:16). setting an example of the believers? (1 Timothy 4:12). Am I using every opportunity presented to me to reach out to precious souls who may never hear the true gospel without my efforts? (Romans 12:11; Hebrews 6:11; 2 Timothy 2:2).




