THE FREEDOM YOU SEEK *By Jonnie Hutchison*

As this nation celebrates July 4th as Independence Day, let us reflect on a sad condition that exists all over our world. Of the world's population of some 7.95 billion people, the overwhelming majority now live in slavery. No, they are not physically enslaved but they are enslaved none the less for they live in the **bondage of SIN!**

The universality of sin is seen in the statement of Romans 3:23 which reads, "*For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.*" Among **accountable** people now living there are no exceptions to this rule. All have transgressed the will of God (1 John 3:4). All have participated in unrighteousness (1 John 5:17). All have failed to do the good they know to do (James 4:17). Thus all have sinned.

The Bible describes this enslaved condition in a number of passages. "*We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one.*" (1 John 5:19). The "wicked one" (akua the devil) is active, tempting and deceiving countless souls (1 Peter

5:8). He is their "master" - they are his slaves. This is the sad condition of so many who, because of ignorance or a hardened heart, do not even realize their enslaved condition. Through their influence they pass this enslaved condition to their children and their children's children and generations to follow. How terribly sad!

Enslavement to sin has both present consequences and eternal consequences. The present consequences of sin include guilt, destroyed relationships, addictions, conflict, crime, depression, suicide, murder, immorality, hopelessness, regret, inner turmoil and frustration just to name a few. The eternal consequence of sin is the separation from God in the punishment of hell from which there will be no escape (Matthew 25:41, 46; 2 Thess. 1:7-9).

When the apostle Paul reflected on his own experiences with sin he asked, "*O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death?*" Inspiration answers "*I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord*" (Romans 7:24

-25). Yes, Jesus is the Only means of being set free from the bondage of sin. In shedding His precious blood on the cross, He provides for the cleansing of sin and an end to its enslavement. To the Christians in Rome Paul wrote, "But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you **obeyed** from the heart that form of **doctrine** to which you were delivered. And having been **set free from sin**, you became slaves of righteousness" (Romans 6:17-18). When is one set free from sin? When he/she obeys from the heart what the Lord has commanded to reach the blood of Jesus. He has commanded the hearing of His word (Romans 10:17), turning

from sin in genuine repentance (Acts 17:30-31), a verbal confession of faith in Christ (Romans 10:9-10), and immersion in water into the death of Jesus to be washed with His cleansing blood (Acts 2:38; 22:16; Romans 6:3-4; Galatians 3:26-27). To maintain this spiritual freedman the hope of eternal life requires continued faithfulness in loving submission day by day in service to the Lord (1 Peter 1:10).

Yes, there is freedom from the bondage of sin. It is found only in Christ Jesus. Let Him set you free from the terrible burden and bondage of sin. He provides the freedom you seek. "Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed" (Jno. 8:36)
