

Christ exhorted, "Search the scriptures" (John 5:39). The Bereans were noble for, along with receiving the Word with all readiness, they "searched the scriptures daily" (Acts 17:11). - The name you wear in religion? Remember, speaking of the name Christ, "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must saved" (Acts 4:12).

In conclusion, we ask, can you be satisfied rapidly and speedily marching toward eternity having patterned your life after matters which you cannot find in the Scriptures? This is a serious matter!


YOU CAN LIVE FOREVER By Jonnie Hutchison


